The Stargard Museum's yearbook is devoted to the history and culture of Stargard itself, the Stargard district and the historic Pomerania. The current volume contains the following essays: Is *Zitarigroda* of 1124 Stargard on the Ina (Ihna)?; New notes on the church in Nowe Warpno (Neu Warp); The clergy and churches of Stargard in the 1378-1471 *Repertorium Germanicum*; Choszczno (Arnswalde) – the Old Town. Results of the rescue excavation at Wolności Street/Rynek in 2008; Gray pottery recovered from the block at the extension of Władysław Łokietek Street (Timber Market) within IXth Quarter in Stargard; Stoneware from Siegburg and Waldenburg in late medieval Stargard; Leather artifacts recovered from the rescue excavation associated with the relocation of water and gas lines at Grodzka Street in Stargard; Building ceramics from the Augustinian Eremite monastic complex in Stargard. An introduction; Studies of architectural detail as an informative medium and its contribution to the research on the Augustinian Eremites monastic complex in Stargard; Location of selected sites associated with penal law in Stargard from XIIIth to XVIIIth century; A Pomeranian relative of the rulers of England and Scotland – imperial lieutenant Daniel von Hebron vel Hepburn (*16.10.1584 Stargard - †8.07.1628 Stargard); Executioner's swords of Pomerania – characteristics of selected objects; Stefan Czarniecki and his subordinates in Neumark and the Duchy of Pomerania in 1656-1659; Biblical motifs on Dutch faience plates from IXth Quarter in Stargard; Jews naturalized in Stargard through the Emancipation Edict of 1812; Hans Lutsch's *Mittelalterliche Backsteinbauten Mittelpommerns* and its place in the reflections on medieval brick architecture in the XIXth century German art history; The Stargard Garrison in World War I; Polish seasonal workers in the Stargard county in the Interbellum – economic aspects; Provisioning of Gdynia in the Interbellum; Sports clubs in the Stargard area before 1945; Notes on the history of sport in the Stargard area up to 1945; Stargard's male troop of the Polish Scouting Association between 1945 and 1950; „Niezależność” (Independence) – the weekly “Solidarity” publication in Stargard – in the context of selected local periodicals; Polemics, reviews, discussions; History of the Mieszko I School in Stargard; Museum life: Museum and school, Exhibits, Reports, Acquisitions: “Seaside landscape with fishermen”. A Dutch wall tile from a monitoring in Stargard; Silk half mitten recovered from IXth Quarter in Stargard.
